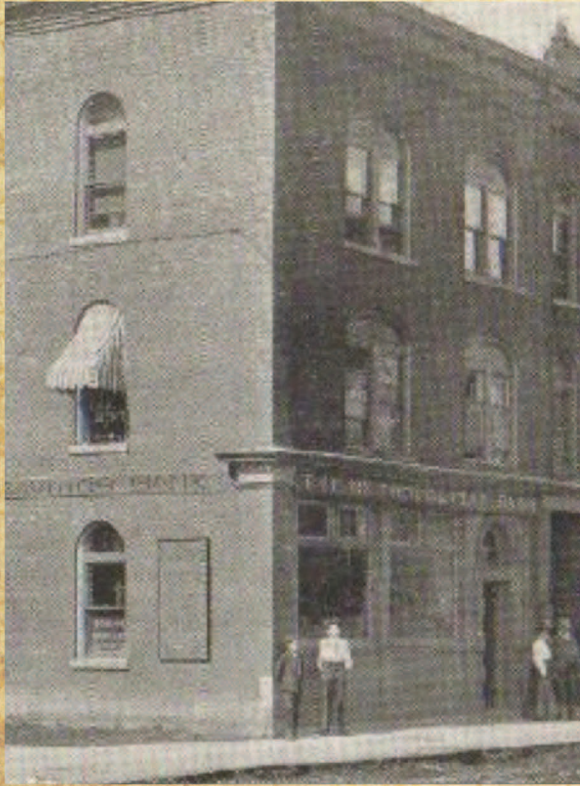


STEADMAN BROTHERS BUILDING 4163-4167 PETROLIA LINE

THE BUILDING NOW

In 1898, J & J Kerr Co. announced plans for a \$40,000 three-story brick block just east of the Tecumseh House, and shortly afterwards this building was erected. The building originally featured a bank, a dry goods store and a grocery. A.C. Darling's Jewellery store was in this structure until Mr. And Mrs. Reg Grandis bought it in 1946.
