

# PETROLIA UTILITIES COMMISSION 4158 PETROLIA LINE



The P.U.C. has been in operation in Petrolia since 1912 when it first ran from the old Masonic Block. The offices later moved into the Town Hall and then to this present location in 1945.



The site used to have a frame building that housed Richmond's Livery, a barbershop and a funeral parlour. It was also site to Waddell's Tailored Men's Clothing store, and later Jack Fraser's second hand store.
