
## HACKETT BLOCK 4152-4154 PETROLIA LINE

J.W. Crosbie built the John Hackett Block in 1889. Its' original cost was \$5,000. John Hackett was the original owner and it stayed in the family, as John William Hackett owned it almost a century later

Ramsay's original store was here.
