

HACKETT BLOCK

4152-4154 PETROLIA LINE

J.W. Crosbie built the John Hackett Block in 1889. Its' original cost was \$5,000. John Hackett was the original owner and it stayed in the family, as John William Hackett owned it almost a century later

The western half was Preston's Tobacco store called 'The Hub'. Occupying the eastern half was Churchill's music store.

Ramsay's original store was here. Gambles Variety, Bargain Hunter's Emporium, Hackett's Egg Market and Corner Crafts have also used the building. Mr. Knight's Shoe Repair, Colonel's Tobacco Store.
